Each is an invitation to contemplate and experience a pivotal moment from Jesus' sentencing to his death to his burial. The Stations of the Cross is a powerful and simple way to reflect on the final moments of Jesus' life. We begin in the main chapel at 1800 followed by a meatless potluck in the fellowship hall around 1845. Please join us for spiritual enrichment and bring a meatless dish to share.

Ordinary Sacrament Schedule (Daenner Chapel)

- Mass Times: Sunday 1130; Holy Days of Obligation 1800
- Daily Mass - Daenner: 1200 Monday, Thursday, 1st/3rd Fridays; LRMC: 1200 Tuesday, Wednesday, 2nd/4th Fridays
- Eucharistic Adoration: The Blessed Sacrament Chapel is open every Friday 0900-1200 for silent prayer and Adoration.
- Rosary: Prayed before Mass (1110) on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of the month. Special 5th Sunday Rosary for Life by the Knights.
- Sacrament of Penance: Confession is available after Sunday and daily Mass, or by appointment by contacting one of our priests.
- **Sacrament of Baptism:** Held during Mass on the last Sunday of the month. Please contact Fr. Alec by email to start the process.
- **Sacrament of Matrimony:** Marriage preparation must be started at least 6 months prior to the planned wedding date. Please contact Fr. Alec by email to start the process.
